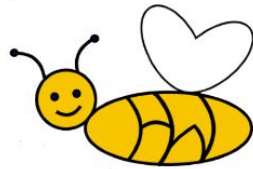

Bees and other pollinating insects have declined significantly over the last 50 years. Together we can give pollinating insects a helping hand by sowing a square metre patch of garden, or a pot, with our **free** wildflower seeds (cornflower, common poppy, corncockle, corn chamomile, corn marigold) and create a patch of colour at the same time.

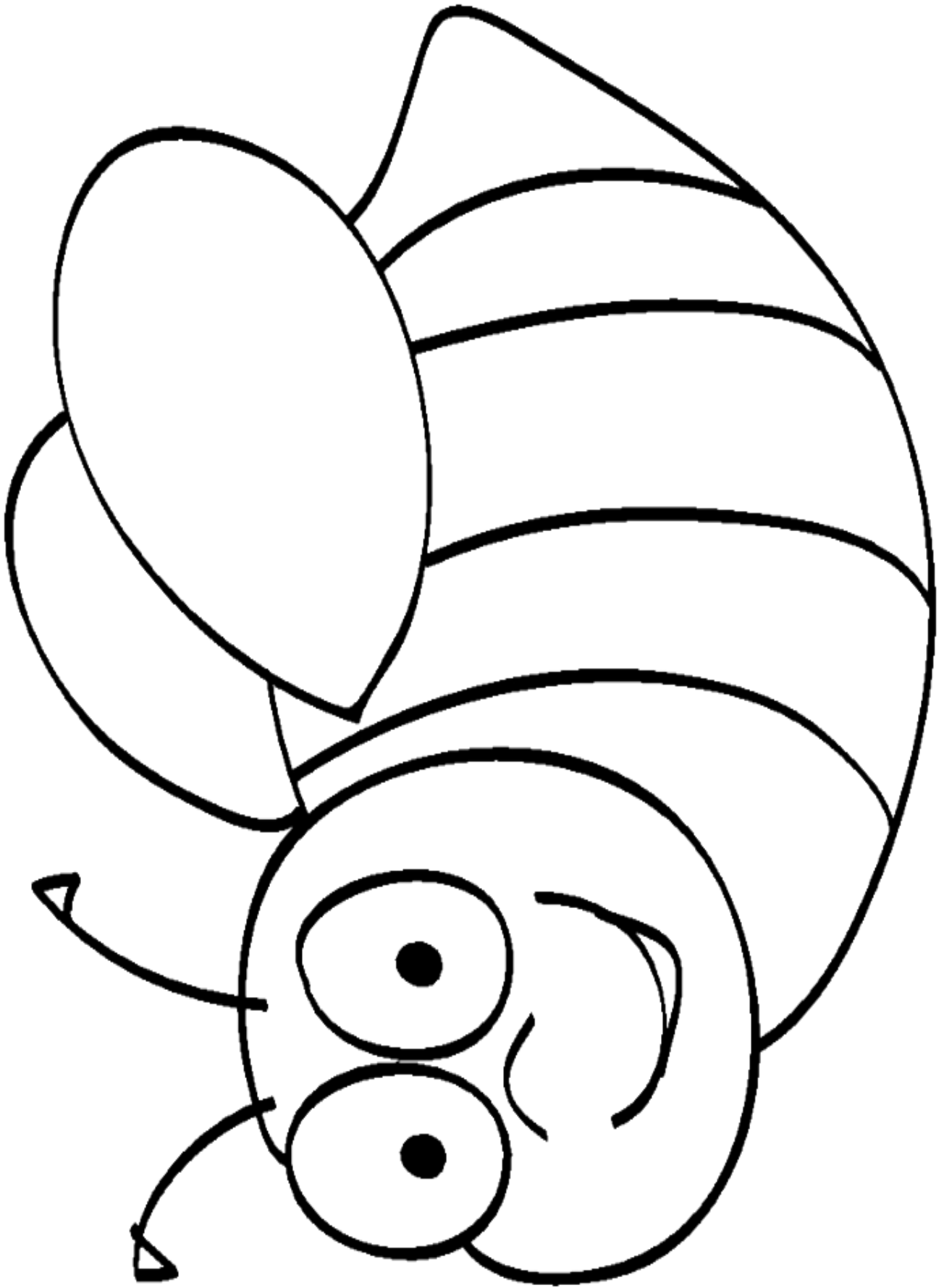
